ICF awards \$600,640 from Gladys E. Langroise Advised Fund

BOISE – The **Gladys E. Langroise Advised Fund** in the Idaho Community Foundation has awarded grants totaling **\$600,640** to nonprofits in every region of Idaho.

The Boise Philharmonic and The College of Idaho received the two largest grants of **\$100,000** followed by the Children's Home Society, which received **\$75,000**.

The Gladys E. Langroise Advised Fund was established through a generous \$15 million bequest to the Idaho Community Foundation from Boise philanthropist Gladys Langroise. It supports the health, education and welfare of children, including college students. Langroise died in early 2000, just prior to her 100th birthday.

The fund advisers annually recommend grants that address what they believe Mrs. Langroise would have considered areas of special interest or greatest need.

In addition to the Boise Philharmonic, The C of I and the Children's Home Society, the following were chosen:
